This probably would only be an issue with appeals to a body such as the Planning Commission, whose agendas cover the whole city and holding items until they could be heard in a certain location might lead to such delays. Failure to process a permit within deadline constraints generally leads to an automatic approval for the applicant, which I believe would be counter to your desires.)

(However, I favor making NCs a formal part of the process by giving them first review of projects before any decision-makers and having NC recommendations be a part of the official record as the case goes forward.)

• The City, at one time, adopted "K" overlays to protect horse-keeping and open space in the City. Since the City falls far short in meeting its open space requirement and the overlays are now being abandoned as "conceptual only", would you move to give these maps a greater level of enforcement?
